Take Charge Program Certificate of Completion Ceremony

(Forestville, Maryland) The Take Charge Juvenile Diversion Program, Inc. has announced the *Certificate of Completion Ceremony* for 11 students who successfully met the objectives of the 12-week intensive group counseling program. The 11 youth were referrals to the Youth Diversion Program, and were sent directly from the Prince George's County Circuit Court- Juvenile Division and the Department of Juvenile Services. The ceremony was held at 6:00 p.m. Thursday, March 22, 2012, at Take Charge headquarters, located at 7610 Pennsylvania Avenue, Forestville, Maryland.

Take Charge Program is a 501c3 non-profit specializing in juvenile gang and crime prevention, intervention, and family strengthening program. Created as an alternative to detention, school expulsion and suspension, the program focuses on cultural pride, family pride, and academic enhancement. Take Charge has been providing services to at-risk youth and their families in the Washington D.C. Metropolitan Area for over 20 years—assisting over 500 families annually.
